So PiKNiK works also close together with Filecoin. They have a lot of GPUs. They have been in Testnet I think since the beginning. I'm not sure if anyone or if a lot of people know this, but they have been supplying GPUs among the rest of the community. They've been very happy with how it went for them, how they've been able to, you know, supply their infrastructure to us.
